FUNDAMENTALS OF EFFECTIVE LEARNING (1)

- Learning is a social as well as an individual activity.
- Feelings, motivation, interest, engagement, enjoyment and effective learning are closely linked.
- Activity, investigation, inquiry, exploration, experience and application are essential.
- Learning is problem-solving.

FUNDAMENTALS OF EFFECTIVE LEARNING (2)

- Trial and error are important for learning.
- Learning must be meaningful.
- Competitive activity inhibits long-term learning.
- Much learning must be unhurried.
- Pressuring students is often counter-productive.
- Punitive environments restrict learning.
- Enjoyment promotes learning.

- Reward students for taking risks.
- Positive and rich feedback are essential.
- Experiencing success is essential.
- Monitoring, assessment and diagnostic teaching are essential.
